"Resurrection Probability"

Brother John Ed Mathison is, without a doubt, one of the most influential pastors in the United States, Indeed, his impact has been felt well beyond the borders of our country. With that said though, I am most grateful for the difference he has made to me personally through the moments of trial and testing in my life. John Ed reflects an admirable trait that Kipling once wrote about—that is, the capacity to "walk with kings yet still retain the common touch."

In the April 8, A.D. 2007 edition of the Frazer (UMC) "Messenger", Dr. Mathison wrote the following article entitled "Resurrection Probability." With his permission, I share his comments with you—the finest church in this conference, in my opinion!

 The July 2002 edition of "Group" magazine shared an interesting resurrection report. In April 2002, Richard Swineburne, wellrespected Oxford University philosophy professor, used a broadly accepted probability theory to defend the truth

- of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. He presented this at a highprofile gathering of philosophy professors at Yale University.
- Swineburne said in a "New York Times" interview, 'For someone dead for 36 hours to come to life again is, according to the laws of nature, extremely improbable. But if there is a God of the traditional kind, natural laws only operate because He makes them operate.'
- the Bayes Theorem to assign values to things like the probability that God is real, the behavior of Jesus during His lifetime, and the quality of witness testimony after His death. He then plugged the numbers into a probability formula and added everything up.
- The result was not surprising—a 97% probability that the resurrection really happened.

 A multitude of eyewitnesses in A.D. 33 were 100% sure that Jesus had been raised from the dead. This led Paul to say that the resurrection of Jesus Christ is the foundation of our faith (1 Corinthians 15:12-58). For him there was no chance of improbability because he experienced Jesus Christ personally (1 Corinthians 15:8).

The resurrection of Jesus Christ is not a theory—it is a reality! His birth, life and ministry, death and resurrection literally split history down the middle!!!

I hope you will join us on Easter Sunday, April 17 at the Epworth United Methodist Church as we celebrate the reality of the resurrection. We will begin the celebration at 7:00 A.M., with an Easter Sunrise service in the parking lot of our Family Life Center (gym), followed by our three morning worship services at 8:30, 9:45 and 11:00 A.M. Remember that people are most receptive to an invitation to worship on Easter Sunday, so invite your family and friends as well!

See you Easter, and keep your hand in Jesus' hand and your eyes on the Cross!


