"Taking Up Our Cross"

The season of Lent—leading up to Easter Sunday on April 9, A.D. 2023—begins with the observation of Ash Wednesday on February 22. The Lenten season typically turns my heart and thoughts to something Jesus told those of us who have chosen to be His disciples: "He who does not take His cross and follow after me is not worthy of me. He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for my sake will find it" (Matthew 10: 38-39). In essence, as faithful followers of the Lord Jesus Christ we are challenged to die to self-will, losing our wills in God's will for us. Our plans and ambitions, our lives and our living--our everything--become secondary to following Jesus and serving God.

Paul, an apostle writing to the Christians in Galatia, said: "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, Who loved me, and delivered Himself up for me" (Galatians 2:20). Writing to the Roman Christians on the same subject, Paul says: "Our old self was crucified with Him, that our body of sin might be done away with, that we

should no longer be slaves to sin" (Romans 6:6). "Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death? Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism unto death, in order that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life" (Romans 6:3-4).

The Apostle Paul's symbolism is potent! As Christians we have not only been forgiven of our sins and cleansed for the sake of Christ, but also challenged to rise above the sins and self-centeredness of our past, becoming a different person altogether! The old person (before Jesus Christ came into our heart and life as our Lord and Savior) is to be put "to death"—that is, "crucified"—done away with. The new person (after Jesus Christ came into our heart and life as our Lord and Savior) is "born again". that we might walk in newness of life. As someone once said, "I may not be what I ought to be, but I'm not what I used to be, nor what I will be by the grace and power of God working in my life!"

Let's take seriously the call to repentance during this holy season of Lent, searching our hearts and lives, and seeking ways to live more like our Master, Jesus Christ, would have us to live. If we find some stronghold of sin in our lives, let's "root it out"—so to speak—that we

might no longer be a slave to sin. Then as we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus on Easter Sunday (April 9), we can also celebrate <u>our</u> newness of life and resurrection from the past!

Keep your hands in Jesus' hand and your eyes on the Cross, my brothers and sisters!
