# A message from our Youth Minister Daniel Cook

Can you believe it...we are already preparing for the summer! To some it may seem early, but in the world of youth ministry, if you do not begin planning now, then there is a good chance you will miss out on things happening during the summer. As you may have heard, sign ups for Summer Camp have begun. I know it may be hard to commit to something 3 months away, but I encourage you to make this a priority for your child.

A lot happens during the week of camp! Here are a few of the top reasons your child needs to attend the summer camp...

An opportunity to connect with God - Camp gives students 4 days to forget about everything going on at home and purposely connect with God. Not only will your student attend worship services, but they will also have a structured daily quiet time, be a part of a small group to dive deeper into the theme of the week, and will be surrounded by 200 students who are seeking God just as they are.

An opportunity to connect with others - What better way to get to know people than spend 4 days/24 hours a day with someone? To some that may sound scary, but getting out of our comfort zone from time to time is a good thing. One reason students say why they do not attend Wednesday night or go on trips is because they do not know anyone. This is a great time to get to know other students and leaders.

An opportunity to have fun - Camp is a week of fun you do not want to miss. Along with all the God moments, students will participate in camp recreation, have an opportunity to swim in the pool and participate in lake activities. Those may include the Aqua Park, where you swim out to inflatables in the lake, the blob, and the Wet Willie! At night, students will have time to hang out around the snack bar, participate in camp competitions, and meet people from other churches.

If you have ever attended any type of summer camp or church camp, you know that memories will be made that you will carry with you for a lifetime. This week is often the best week of summer for students. Encourage your child to come, so they do not miss out on a week of fun, building friendships with students who are seeking Jesus like they are, and an opportunity for their life to be changed by God? If you cannot make this trip, keep these in mind to encourage your student to attend the next one.

Once a month we split off into small groups to discuss the topic of the night and talk about how we can apply it to our lives.

#### **Sunday Mornings Worship**

We invite all families and teenagers to attend a Sunday morning worship service. As you know there are three to choose from, with most teenagers attending the 9:45 service. We would love to see your family worship with us!

#### Small Group - Sunday Mornings at 11:00

Following the 9:45 service there is a class offered for all teenagers. Some may call it Sunday School and others call it a Small Group, no matter what you call it, it is important. This is a place for teenagers to talk through the Bible and life with other teenagers to grow together as they navigate what it means to follow Christ.
