Fear Not - Good Words from the Good Shepherd

In God's word, the Holy Bible, we read in Ephesians 2:8 that we are "saved through faith." In Acts 2:21 the Bible tells us, "whoever calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved!" It's a plain and simple fact: we have all sinned and fallen short of the glory of God—every person needs to be saved from their sins through a personal faith in Jesus Christ in order to have everlasting life in "the hereafter." (Romans 3:23, John 3:16)

But I am convinced that a personal faith in Jesus Christ also saves us to an *abundant* life of peace and joy and contentment right now, in "the *here and now!*" For example, one thing Jesus seems to want to save us from is <u>fear</u>. In fact, it's been said that the most frequent command in the Bible is "fear not," or some similar form of that command. Here's two examples.

A ruler of the synagogue came to Jesus one day and said, "My daughter is at the point of death. Come and lay hands on her, that she might live." Then someone from the ruler's house came to the man and said, "Your daughter is already dead, why trouble Jesus any further?" But ignoring what they said, Jesus said to the ruler of the synagogue, "Do not fear—only believe." (Mark 5:22-36)

Again, one evening, Jesus was on a boat with His disciples and a great wind came up. The waves started beating against the sides of the boat. The disciples were frightened, and I'm sure there was no small amount of weeping, wailing, and gnashing of teeth! They looked to find Jesus sound asleep. They woke Him and said, "Teacher, do you not care if we perish?" Jesus rebuked the wind and said to the sea. "Peace, be still." The wind ceased, and there was great calm on the water. Then He turned to His disciples (and to us as well, I believe) and said, "Why are you afraid? Have you no faith?" (From Mark 4:35-40)

Let me ask you a question today that only you can answer. Do you have fears in your life—in your heart or in your mind—for some reason today? Then let these good words from our Good Shepherd, Jesus Christ comfort you: "Do not fear—only believe!" The One who calmed the raging sea can surely settle the storm that is surging within you!

Keep your hand in Jesus' hand and your eyes on the Cross! Brother Grant



A message from our Youth Minister Daniel Cook

The summer has officially arrived! Most of you have already made plans for a family vacation, pool days, and time to relax and enjoy the sunshine! During this time of relaxing and spending time with family and friends, this time can be leveraged to grow ourselves and others closer to Christ. Let's go into summer with a plan to make the most of the time we have this summer.

The first way we can take advantage of our summer break is to spend more time reading God's word. Psalm 119:105 says, "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." If you are not already reading your Bible now is a great time to start a Bible reading plan. There are many resources available to help you start reading your Bible. As you are sitting at the pool, on the beach, or at your table drinking your morning coffee take a few minutes to allow God to speak to you through the Bible.

The second way we can take advantage of our summer break is by being intentional with the time we have with our family. As we spend more time together enjoying vacations or pool days, remember Deuteronomy 6:6-9, "6 And you must commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands that I am giving you today.7 Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up. 8 Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders. 9 Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates." This instructs us to teach God's commands to our children all of the time, no matter where we are. As you travel, sit beside a pool, or stand around a grill, find ways to have meaningful conversations about Christ.

The third way we can take advantage of our summer break is to grow our relationships closer together and closer to God. As you get together this summer with family and friends, be intentional to make the most of your time with fellow believers. Hebrews 10:24-25, says, "And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near." Instead of having just another pool day, maybe you start a small group with your friends around the pool or you make a plan to go spend time with someone who needs encouragement.

If we are not intentional with the time we have it will be easily wasted and we come to the end of the summer missing out on opportunities to grow in our faith and to grow with those around us. As you go throughout this summer make the most of the time you have with your family and friends. Now go and enjoy the sunshine!!!

June Wednesday Night Series - Worth Sharing

There are some things we just have to share. A funny video, some encouraging words, or a profound moment of kindness are all things we've probably shared this week. When we share, we just want the people we care about most to experience what we have. We're quick to send videos to each other, but how easy is it for us to share our faith? Maybe it's not that we don't want to share, but we might have a hard time overcoming some of our obstacles or insecurities. During this four-week series, we'll take a look at the story of Samuel and the ways that God called him to share his faith through words and action. Together, we'll explore how God invites us to share the good news, why sharing the good news should start with prayer, what to do when sharing the good news requires risk, and how sharing the good news can happen every day.

Join us on **Wednesday night from 6:00 - 6:30** as we hang out in the gym, game room, and snack bar. From 6:30 - 7:30 we have our service that includes a time of games, teaching, and worship. Sound Choices Baby Bottle Boomerang

Every week Sound Choices ministers to women & girls that are facing an unplanned pregnancy. They do this by providing free pregnancy testing, a trusted advocate to talk with, an ultrasound, and referrals for community resources. These women are given the opportunity to hear the gospel, see the value of their life and the life of their unborn baby, and understand how much God loves them.

Starting Mother's Day, May 12th, we will distribute baby bottles from Sound Choices Pregnancy Clinic. Please take one per family. We are asking that you take the bottles home, fill them with a check, cash or coins, and return them to the church on Father's Day, June 16th.
