# A message from our Youth Minister Daniel Cook

Without April showers, there would be no May flowers!" How true this is! This month, you might find your plans changed or be stuck indoors with the kids due to the rain. While it may dampen our immediate plans, remember that these showers are necessary and purposeful. Just as the rain nourishes the earth, God uses life's "showers" – the unexpected changes, the frustrating delays – to nourish our souls and bring forth new growth. Let's embrace the purpose in every season, trusting that God is working, even when we can't see the blooms yet.

### Scripture:

"Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything." (James 1:2-4, NIV)

This month, we'll experience a variety of rains – a drizzle, a downpour, a quick shower, or days of steady rain. Just as the rain varies, so do the trials we face. Some pass quickly, others linger.
